

Year 1 Spelling and Handwriting Activities for Wb May 18th

The 'ou' digraph. This digraph can be found at the beginning and in the middle of words. The only common English word ending in 'ou' is you.

Spelling Rule

Teach the spelling rule and read the spellings together, using sound buttons and looking at the meaning of each word. Can they put the word in an oral sentence that makes sense?

Look at writing the spellings and then putting the word in a sentence using correct punctuation- capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

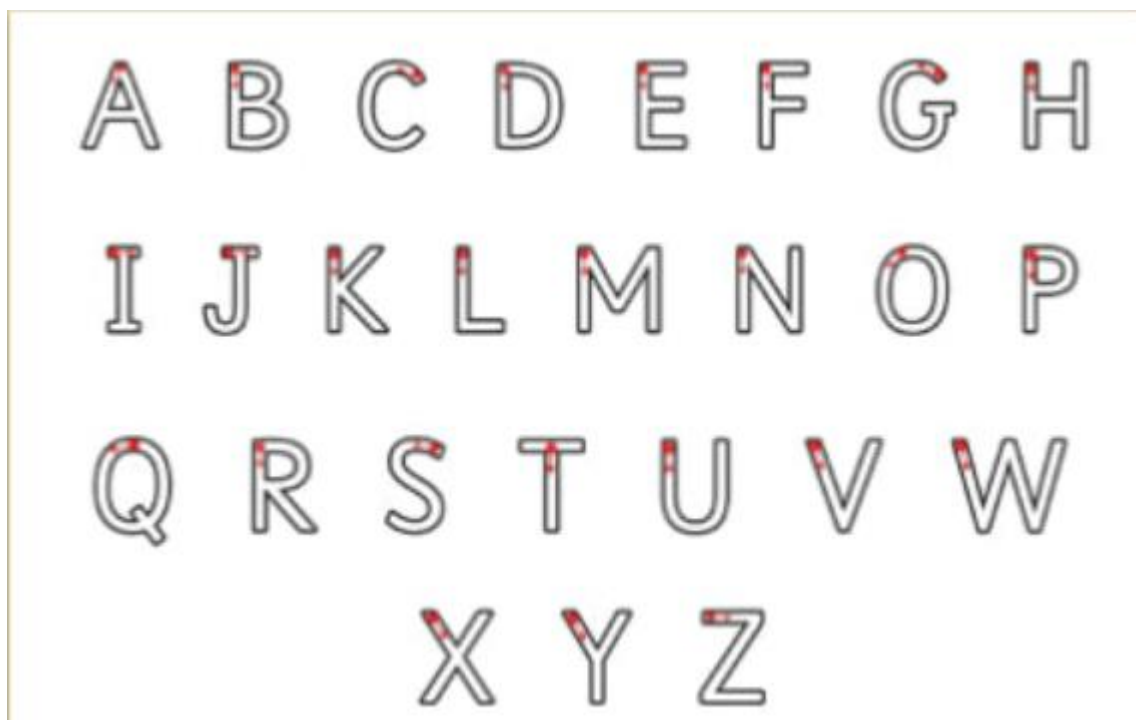
Can you find and colour your spellings hiding in this grid.

Focus on the correct letter formation of capital letters.

This week you could choose 5 or more capital letters, looking at the formation together, modelling the correct formation to your child and then supporting them in forming each capital letter correctly.

Challenge- Can you write a sentence that starts with each capital letter?



Support your child to form these letters correctly, ensuring their letters sit on the line and are formed correctly, starting at the correct place and not taking their pencil off.
