Monday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise flashcard letter sound game on Phonic Play Phase 3 games Flashcards Speed Trial, click on “start”, then “Phase 2” to practice the sounds you have learned already at school. https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/member-only/Flashcards.html Adult to write down letters j, v, w, x, y, z, qu, sh, ch, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo (long), oo (short), ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure and practice saying the sounds they make. Adult to write down the alphabet. Sing the alphabet and point to each letter and you sing each name. Introduce letter and sounds er. Make an action with both arms like pretending to be an electric whisk mixing gingerbread, say “errrrrrr”. Write er with a grown up. Think of things that have er in them: her, sister, brother, dinner, summer. Adult to write down these words and put a dot under each sound. Point to the dots as you say the sounds: her (h-er), hammer (h-a-mm-er), letter (l-e-tt-er), ladder (l-a-dd-er), supper (s-u-pp-er), dinner (d-i-nn-er), better (b-e-tt-er), summer (s-u-mm-er). An adult can write these sentences out for you to read. With an adult blend to read these sentences: I got a letter from the farmer. My ladder was longer than her ladder. Get a hammer and bang in a nail.
